Argyll and Bute Geography

Eligible Properties:

Privately owned or privately rented properties which are registered in Council Tax band A, B or C.

Privately owned properties registered in Council Tax band D with a household energy rating of E, F or G.

Islands Only: In addition to the above, privately owned properties in Council Tax Band E to H if they have a household energy rating of E, F or G (subject to approval)

Argyll and Bute Council offers the following insulation measures:

- External wall insulation
- Park Home insulation
- Internal wall insulation
- Cavity wall insulation
- Loft insulation
- Underfloor insulation
- Room-in-Roof insulation
