



ScottishPower Renewables

What is ECO?



Energy Company Obligation (ECO)

1st Apr 2022 – 31st Mar 2026

Support the most vulnerable households in the least efficient homes

- Vulnerable households in or at risk of fuel poverty
- Inefficient homes = EPC Bad D, E, F or G

Funding for fabric first, whole house retrofit


- Fabric first = property maintained and insulated to retain heat
- PAS2035 holistic approach to retrofit
- Low carbon heating upgrades

Improve energy performance on households by 2 x EPC bands

D&E - C

- £4Bn Budget across energy sector
- Consumer protection: PAS2030; MCS;
 Trustmark accredited supply chain

Pre-Install assessment identifies condition of property (SAP score / EPC Band)

Primary fabric improvements required before heating measures can be supported



- | Smart meter upgrade






Investment of over £20k

Great British Insulation Scheme (GBIS)

1st Apr 2022 – 31st Mar 2026

GBIS / ECO+

- Designed as a single measure scheme
- Cost-effective measures at scale
- £1Bn budget across energy sector

Low Income Group
20% of target

- ECO4 qualification criteria
- EPC Band D-G
- No Cost

Generals Group
80% of target

- EPC Band D-G
- Council Tax Band A-E (Scotland)
- Contributions may be required




