Home Energy Scotland Loan Scheme

The Home Energy Scotland grant and loan scheme provides homeowners in Scotland a grant, interest free loan or a combination of both to install clean heating systems and energy efficient measures.

You can apply for the Home Energy Scotland grant and loan if you're a homeowner. You can get grants for energy efficiency improvements – for example, insulation, and clean heating systems such as heat pumps.

The amount you can get depends on what improvements you want to make.

For some improvements the maximum grant is less.

You do not have to pay it back.

You could also get an interest-free loan to cover some of your costs.

Check the amount you could get for different improvements on the Home Energy Scotland website.

Rural households

If you live in a rural area, you can apply for extra grant funding. Please inform Home Energy Scotland if you live in a rural area.

If you're unsure, Home Energy Scotland can tell you if you're a rural household.

What you can get funding for

You can get a grant or loan for improvements that are recommended in either your home's:

- Energy Performance Certificate (EPC)
- Home Energy Improvement Report
- Home Renewable Selector Report

Check if your home has an Energy Performance Certificate on the Scottish EPC register website.

Home Energy Scotland can help you get these if you do not have one.
